Dr. Önal was born in 1962 and was graduated from Tarsus American High School, Mersin in 1980. He became a medical doctor in 1986 licensed from Istanbul University Istanbul Medical School. Dr. Önal attended the neurosurgery training program in 1989 and became a neurosurgeon in 1996 in the same faculty, Istanbul University Istanbul School of Medicine. He received the Turkish Neurosurgical Society Scientific Research Award in 1998 with his work "The effect of intraventricular albumin in experimental brain oedema" published in Acta Neurochirurgica. He became an assistant professor in 1998, in Inonu University School of Medicine Department of Neurosurgery, Malatya. Dr. Önal worked for one year (2000-2001) in Toronto University School of Medicine Department of Neurosurgery – Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto, Ontario, Canada as a clinical observer and clinical research fellow as a scholar of Turkish Neurosurgical Society. He became associate professor in 2003 and full professor in 2010 in Inonu University School of Medicine, Department of Neurosurgery, Malatya. Dr.Önal worked as Dean of Dentistry in Inonu University in 2016-2018. He is the current chief of the department of neurosurgery in Inonu University School of Medicine with special interest in pediatric neurosurgery. Dr. Önal is the current head of the pediatric section of Turkish Neurosurgical Society. He is a member of ISPN, ESPN and EANS.
