The position is a full-time position in paediatric orthopaedics and paediatric traumatology. The job is located at the Department of Orthopaedics, Olgahospital, Klinikum Stuttgart.

The Olgahospital represents one of the largest paediatric hospitals in Germany. Klinikum Stuttgart is the largest hospital in the federal state of Baden-Württemberg, not a university hospital for itself, but affiliated to the University of Tübingen. The Department of Orthopaedics is one of the largest Paediatric Orthopaedic Departments within Germany and the only one that includes Paediatric Traumatology as an integrated part of the department. The department is driven by 9 consultants, paediatric orthopaedic surgeons, who have adopted more or less all subspecialities in paediatric orthopaedics and traumatology and treat the full spectrum including spine deformities, neuromuscular diseases, benign and malignant bone tumours. There is also a fully equipped gait laboratory. There is the opportunity to participate in clinical research. The position includes all regular medical activities including participation in on-calls. We appreciate if the candidate has advanced knowledge of the German language.

centre that would claim you after you complete your Paediatric Orthopaedic

Fellowship. A letter of your future centre, stating that you have a job offer after

your Fellowship, would be taken in account.

An initial selection will be done based on the documentation presented. Candidates

shortlisted would be selected for an interview.
